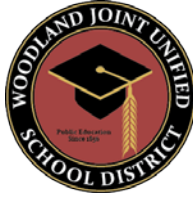

Dear Woodland Joint Unified School District Students, Families, and Friends:

Welcome back to the new school year! As we prepare for the school year, there are many adjustments we are expected to make per the State and County health guidelines associated with COVID-19. Staff has been preparing for the opening of school to provide our students with the best learning experience while keeping everyone safe. We are looking forward to the first day of instruction with our students beginning on Monday, August 31, 2020.

The Woodland Joint Unified School District will follow a phased-in approach as we reopen our schools. On August 31, we will begin on Phase 1: Remote Learning, and will continue in Phase 1 until conditions allow us to begin to phase back to in-person support and instruction for all subject areas. As we prepare for the beginning of the school year, we would like to describe the program options for our students and families.

### **Program Options for Phase 1**

**Remote Learning:** Every student is automatically enrolled at their regular school of attendance. By default, all students will begin the school year in Remote Learning. During this time of Remote Learning, students will meet with their teachers on a daily basis to receive live instruction and support in all subject areas. Built into the daily schedules, students will have several opportunities to interact with each other, continue to reinforce and establish friendships, and attend virtual field trips and guest speakers. The intent of this program option is to provide a full and enriching educational experience, starting in an online environment, and then phasing back into in-person instruction, as conditions allow. All instruction will be supported through the learning management system, Canvas.

The Remote Learning Model will include a fixed schedule and will consist of both synchronous (live online interaction) and asynchronous (independent learning) learning experiences. Synchronous instruction will be provided for core subject-specific blocks. In addition to the core subjects, students will have interactive read-alouds, art, music, PE, and library. For our elementary classes, specifics regarding what subject is being taught at each block will vary by teacher. **Samples of elementary**

**schedules have been included with this letter, as well as the Middle School and High School schedules.** Please note that elementary students will receive specific schedules from their school teachers before the start of school. Middle School and High School students will receive their schedules after the Data Confirmation process is completed. Please contact your child's school for more information.

We understand that in these uncertain times, some families may wish to not participate in a phase-in approach back to in-person learning. In order to support families with this desire, families can choose to participate in our Independent Learning Programs, through K-8 Home Study (TK-8th grade) and the Independent Learning Center (High School). These programs are designed to support all learning from home and will not phase into daily in-person instruction. To enroll in these programs, families should contact the Enrollment Center at 530-406-3240.

### **K-8 Home Study**

The K-8 Home Study program provides an alternative to regular classroom instruction. Daily instruction is overseen by the parents under the support and guidance of a supervising credentialed teacher. Regular one hour, virtual meetings are scheduled to support parents and students, monitor progress, discuss lesson plans, provide instruction as time permits, and collect samples of completed work. Students may continue to receive specialized services during their enrollment in K-8 Home Study.

### **Independent Learning Center (ILC)**

The Woodland Joint Unified School District Independent Learning Center (ILC) is an alternative educational program offered to students to meet graduation requirements and receive a diploma. ILC students have a course of work developed to meet their particular needs. Classes and homework contracts meet the requirements for graduation and are comparable to the classes offered at the traditional high school programs. To support the educational goals of all of our students, many courses will be offered online through the online curriculum providers (UC Scout and CyberHigh). Students will connect with teachers on a regular basis through video conferencing to monitor progress, receive feedback, and support the student with their individualized needs. All instruction will be supported through the learning management system, Canvas.

We would like to thank the entire Woodland Joint Unified School District community for your understanding, cooperation, and support through these challenging times. Despite all that is occurring around the world, the Woodland Joint Unified School District remains committed to our mission of preparing and empowering all students for a future of endless possibilities.
